

University Examinations and Attempts

- a. The learner shall not be entitled to graduate later than 10 years of joining the MBBS course.
- b. No more than four attempts shall be allowed for a candidate to pass the first phase (partial attendance is counted as an attempt) and not later than four years of joining the course.
- c. Candidates passing in the supplementary examination shall join with the main batch for progression and the candidates failing in the supplementary examination shall take the examination with the subsequent batch in the next year.
- d. A candidate failing in second MBBS shall not be allowed to take Third Phase-Part I examination, unless he/she passes in all the subjects.
- e. Passing in the examination of Phase III part I is compulsory to be eligible for Third Phase Part II examinations.
- f. In subjects having two papers, the learner must obtain a minimum of 40% marks in each paper and an aggregate of 50% marks to pass in the subject. For the practical session, marks for practicals and viva are added together and the learner must obtain 50% aggregate score to pass in the subject.
