## 2. Student Training Opportunities:

- The parties intend to create short-term and long-term training opportunities for:
  - National and international medical students
  - Technical staff
  - Doctors pursuing postgraduate studies
  - Undergraduate students interested in Implementation Science, Public Health, and Health Economics.

## 3. Faculty Exchange Programme:

- The FIRSTPARTY and the SECONDPARTY agree to facilitate faculty exchange between their institutions.
- Faculty members from both parties may participate in teaching, research, and knowledge-sharing activities.
- Exchange programs will promote cross-cultural understanding and academic collaboration.

## 4. Ethics Committee Services:

- The FIRSTPARTY may utilize the services of the Ethics Committee of Sree Gokulam Medical College for reviewing their research projects in India.
- The SECONDPARTY shall provide timely and efficient ethical review processes to support the FIRST PARTY's research initiatives.

## 5. RED Cap Data Invitation and Non-Profit Collaboration:

- The parties acknowledge the importance of data management and invite each other to collaborate on research projects involving RED Cap (Research Electronic Data Capture) systems.
- When necessary, the SECONDPARTY may seek non-profit organizations to initiate or partner in the process of data collection, management, and analysis.

## Scope of Service:

The parties agree to work together for mutual benefit and common interest in the field of training and research. The scope of service includes, but is not limited to:

### Research Collaboration:

- Sharing expertise, resources, and data for joint research projects.
- Conducting collaborative studies, clinical trials, and epidemiological research.
- Publishing research findings in reputable journals.

## 2. Student Training:

- Providing training opportunities for medical students and technical staff.
- Organizing workshops, seminars, and conferences related to Public Health, Implementation Science Research, Health Economics, and Cancer Epidemiology.
- Facilitating exchange programs for students and faculty members.

## 3. Faculty Exchange:

- Encouraging faculty members to participate in exchange programs.
- Promoting knowledge transfer, teaching, and research collaboration.
- Supporting visiting faculty during their stay at the partner institution.

## Term and Termination:

This MOU shall be in effect from the date of execution and continue for a period of three years. Either party may terminate this agreement by providing written notice atleast one month prior to the intended termination date.
