- 1. Any Topic related to Forensic Medicine and Toxicology can be chosen
- 2. Maximum allotted time is 5 minutes (3 +2 minutes for Discussion)
- 3. E poster should be designed in MS Power Point in Landscape mode with size of 16:9

GUIDELINES FOR FREE PAPER PRESENTATION For Forensic Medicine faculty members and Postgraduate students

- 1. Any Topic related to Forensic Medicine and Toxicology can be chosen.
- 2. The same paper should not have been presented or published earlier.
- 3. Maximum allotted time is 7 minutes (5 +2 minutes for Discussion).

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- 1. The Abstract should be in MS word in Times New Roman, Font size 12.
- Abstract should not exceed 250 words.
- 3. Title should be in CAPITAL LETTERS, short and concise.
- 4. Author/s name/s should be in CAPITAL LETTERS.
- 5. Name of the presenting author should be underlined followed by the name of the Institution.
- 6. Abstract should be structured under the following headings

For Original Articles: Introduction, Objectives, Materials&Methods, Results, Conclusion. For Case Reports: Introduction, Case Details, Discussion.
