



Program Outcomes (PO)

POs are designed to be achievable within the time frame of the duration of the program through the component courses, and are measurable and realistic. A student graduating from the undergraduate medical education program (MBBS) at Sree Gokulam Medical College & Research Foundation should be able to:

PO1: Clinical competence: Demonstrate ability to manage clinical cases in all settings by taking history, examining the patient, diagnose, request and interpret investigations, draw management plans, document the clinical encounter and provide evidence-based compassionate care to the patients.

PO2: Planning and problem solving skills: Participates actively in decision making regarding patient care. Advocates for disease prevention and promotion of healthy lifestyles. Demonstrates ability to identify system failure and suggest measures for safety or improvement. Demonstrate the ability to assimilate or generate new evidence through research and utilise it judiciously in patient care.

PO3: Communication skills: Demonstrate the ability to listen, communicate and educate patients, caregivers, community and professionals for the promotion of health, diagnosis of disease and the treatment of illness. Demonstrates ability to communicate in a non-judgemental manner with patients and community and encourages participation.

PO4: Adhere to ethical, legal and professional standards: Demonstrates professional responsibility towards patients & colleagues, adhere to universal code of ethics and demonstrates awareness of medico-legal implication. Demonstrates honesty, integrity, empathy and compassion in patient care or in the care of biological tissues.

PO5: Lifelong learner: Demonstrates ability to learn new skills and evolving knowledge, and apply the knowledge in patient care, in personal and professional growth. Demonstrates self-motivation and awareness of self-limitation. Demonstrates digital literacy for evidence based medicine & research.
