

Graduation Ceremony

Statement of Purpose

Graduation ceremony is the culmination of a student's successful completion of MBBS program. The policy states the schedule and eligibility criteria for graduating and participating in graduation ceremony in the Institution.

Policy

The Institution shall hold a Graduation Ceremony in the month of April / May every year for the students who meet with the eligibility criteria by completing all the requirements for graduation. The college celebrates the achievement of its graduands by conducting Graduation Ceremony, a ceremony of solemnity where the students are administered Hippocratic Oath after which they are eligible to practice medicine.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Students must have passed in the Phase III, part II
- Student must have obtained the pass certificate and provisional certificate from the University.
- Student must have obtained the Provisional Registration Number with the Travencore - Cochin Council for Modern Medicine (or Travencore Medical Council).
- Students must have completed one year compulsory Rotational Internship.

Application Details:

Eligible students must apply for graduation in the month of February by

- Submitting the completed application form
- Providing the copies of required documents
- Providing a copy of photo ID
- Providing a passport sized and a large photograph of self and immediate family members.
