Statement of purpose

The policy outlines the formation and functioning of the Alumni Association.

Policy

The Alumni Association Shall be known as Sree Gokulam Medical College Alumni Association (SGMCAA) and it is a registered body (Reg. No: 297/IV/2019 dated 30.12.2019, SRO TVPM)

A student, who has studied MBBS in Sree Gokulam Medical College & Research Foundation and completed the course only can become the member of the association.

Application form with Registration fee of Rs.1000/- shall be submitted by the prospective member for the membership.

Yearly Recruiting Plan: After the completion of internship, membership form is given to each students and those who are voluntarily willing shall submit the application form with fee.

General Body meeting shall be conducted annually.

Executive Committee shall have a President, a Vice President, a General Secretary, Two joint secretaries and a Treasurer. Executive members shall be elected in the Annual General Body meeting. Executive Committee shall function for a term of 2 years.

Executive Committee meetings shall be conducted every 6 monthly.
