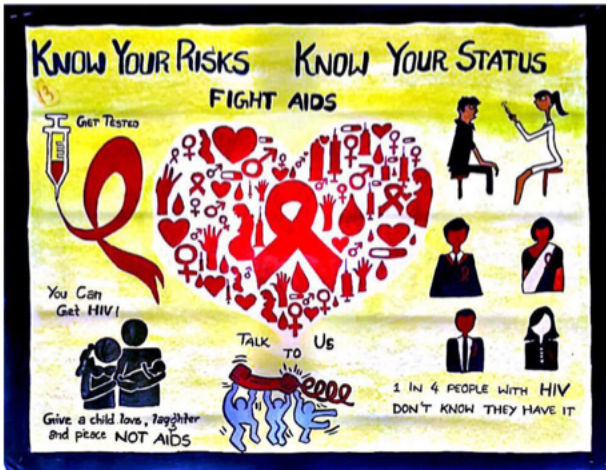




World AIDS day

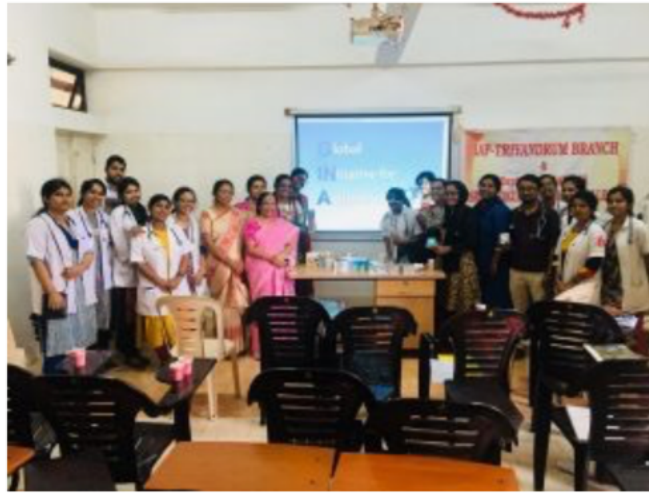

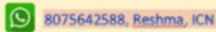
