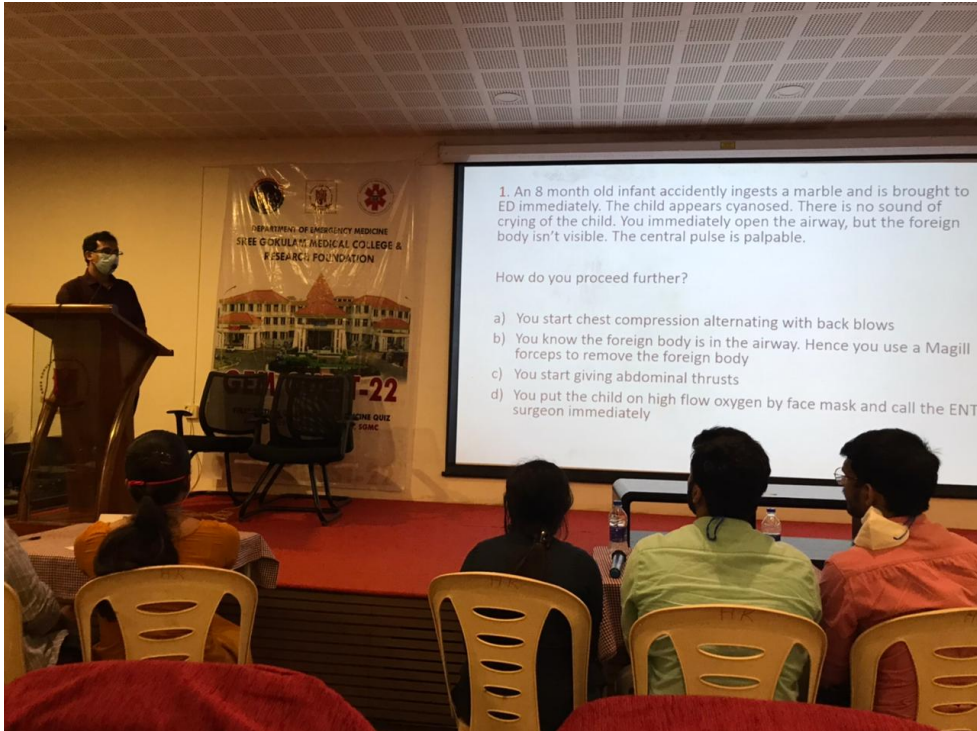

1. An 8 month old infant accidentally ingests a marble and is brought to ED immediately. The child appears cyanosed. There is no sound of crying of the child. You immediately open the airway, but the foreign body isn't visible. The central pulse is palpable.

How do you proceed further?
