The training will cover the National Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical and Health Research Involving Human Participants (ICMR 2017), GCP guidelines issued by the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO), and the New Drugs and Clinical Trials Rules, 2019 (NDCTR) (2023 version).

IMPORTANCE OF TRAINING

Ethics and GCP training is crucial in the field of biomedical research to ensure the protection of human participants and the integrity of the research process. This training is mandatory for all researchers as per the NDCT rules 2019 and for postgraduate students as per the NMC guidelines. This training is also a mandatory requirement for eligibility to be a member of the Institutional Ethics Committee (IEC).
